ATTENTION SOUTHERN REGION DRIVERS:

Effective January 2017, ALL REGULAR AND SENIOR SLALOM Drivers are required to submit an end course (EC) video for slalom as described below:.

 ALL Regular and Senior Slalom Drivers who do not drive in Record Tournaments (record tournaments see below) are required to submit approx ½ hour (max 1 hour) slalom video on a yearly basis. This may be done at a Class C/F tournament or practice with a hand-held camera on a tripod at the end of the lake.

RECORD TOUR NAMENTS:

- ALL REGULAR AND SENIOR Slalom Drivers are required to submit an end course (EC) video for slalom, approx. ½ hour (max 1 hour) of your Tournament Driving for <u>Each</u> <u>Record Tournament</u> you drive. Drivers should identify the time of day driven for exporting files and should be the shorter line length/max speeds.
- The LOC is to maintain ALL the EC video for minimum of 1 year. On occasion, a complete tournament will be requested for download. This will be on a random basis.
- The TC will support the Drivers/CD in getting the required video from the DVR in the proper format described below

.FILE NAME

- From DVR/SEARCH, Copy the EC Channel for the specific time.
- Using the DVR Player (EF Player), convert the file to the correct format as identified below (avi).
- Re-name the file by tournament sanction number and the driver name. (Ex: 17S070HAM.avi).
- NOTE: Approximately 1 hour of video is approx. 400mb. It takes approximately 5 minutes to copy from DVR to USB and it takes approximately15 minutes to upload to the Drop Box depending on speed.

All links will provide upload instructions.

Each video will be reviewed by a member(s) of the Southern Region Review Board. This will be an ongoing process throughout the year. This will provide data for evaluation/driving style between all the Regions and education for drivers and judges. This is not meant to be a punitive process.
